By showing the love of God and holding forth the Word of Life to these students we hope to see real and profound changes occur in their lives.

Beth-Haran was placed on the heart of Jeff and Hannah Barnes in the fall of 2005. They desired to create a home for hurting young women and teach the grace and mercy of God. In the spring of 2006 God provided the perfect farm for this ministry. Beth-Haran is located on a fourteen acres, nestled in the beautiful mountains of Coquille, Oregon. The property consists of a large home, year-round creek, garden, pastures and small barn for animal husbandry.

Our one year, residential program emphasizes discipleship by mature Christians, prayer and Bible study. These things are learned in a family setting along with hard work around the farm and community service.

The student with a willing heart is given an opportunity to grow and mature into Christ likeness.

Our Discipleship Program

Our aim is to disciple each student that comes to us in a family setting. We eat, work, play and fellowship together. Our daily schedule consists of personal and family devotional times, classes, hard work and other types of training and activities. Through the course of our daily lives we will emphasize the following:

Accountability – Each girl who comes will be placed on one month of strict coverage and will be released from these restrictions as she shows herself faithful. She will be encouraged by our staff to follow all house rules, and will be confronted on wrong attitudes and actions.

Responsibility – As a ranch family there is a lot of work to be done. The students themselves will carry out



much of this work. In this way we hope to instill a good work ethic and a good nights sleep. We want her to experience the satisfaction that comes from of being a productive member of society.

Bible Training – Our young ladies will be required to attend classes each day. These will center mainly around the Bible. She will study the New Testament with us, and learn how she can it apply to her life.

Fellowship – Many of the girls who come to us have never experienced normal family life. For these girls we feel that discipleship can best take place living and working together as a family. Through the example of our staff and volunteers we desire that each girl will have many opportunities to witness the fruit of the Spirit lived out in the lives of those around her. In this way we hope that she will desire this fruit in her own life as well.

Prayer – It is only by the power of God that any of us can stand. It is essential that our girls learn to go directly to the source of their hope, strength and help. One of our goals is that by the time our girls leave us they will have developed

a genuine relationship with Him that only comes through prayer.
